Jesus said the force and power of the Holy Spirit, like the wind, is not completely discernible by the senses, but completely transformational in its impact. God is always here, working in our lives in ways that we do not always understand; moving our lives toward gloriously unexpected points of blessing! *It is still the same in this generation when He chooses people for His high and noble purposes within the kingdom.*
