### Here are some things the adults are learning about that we can learn too!

Revelation 12:11, "They had victory over him (Satan) by the blood the Lamb (Jesus) spilled for them. They had victory over him (Satan) by speaking the truth about Jesus to others. They were willing to risk their lives, even if it led to death."

- Who does it say has victory over Satan? The people who speak the truth about Jesus to others and are even willing to risk their lives for Jesus.
- What kind of victory is this? This is victory over sin and Satan through Jesus' death on the cross and His rising to life.
- This is not victory like we think...
  - It is not military defeat, not economic gain, not political power.
  - It doesn't come from violence.
  - This victory doesn't look like victory to the world. It involves people disliking us; people not liking us speaking the truth about Jesus; it is people being mean to us because we follow Jesus.
- This seems confusing because we often forget...
  - We are looking forward to eternal life to come with Jesus in heaven. This is what we're living for!
  - While we're on earth, our goal isn't happiness for ourselves. Our goal is to tell others about eternal life with Jesus. Others need to know about eternal life with Jesus so they don't miss out!

**READ AND DISCUSS:** We are going to review this week, reading again Matthew 26, 27, & 28:1-10 or "Jesus is Arrested and Crucified" and "Jesus is Risen" in The Beginner's Bible starting on pages 446 and 453.

Questions to discuss:

1. Jesus didn't have to die. Even after He was arrested, He could have asked God to save Him. Why was Jesus willing to die in such a terrible way?
2. What happened three days after Jesus was put in the tomb?

**MEMORIZE:** Joshua 1:9 "Have I not commanded you, be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go."

1. Cut out the cards on the second page (or make your own) with different ways to recite the verse.
2. Mix up the cards.
3. Have one person draw a card and everyone should try saying the verse together following the instructions on the card.

#### **Easter Quiz Rules:**

Divide group into teams of 2-4 people. Give each team something to write with and a stack of index cards or sheets of paper cut into 3"x5" strips. As a question is asked give each team 30 seconds to write their answer on a card; they may talk among their team and/or look up the Bible reference to decide on the answer. When time is up, have the teams turn their answers over. If the answer is correct they get the number of points assigned to the question. If none are correct give them the verse reference where it is found, and the first team that finds the answer gets the points.

### Level 1 - Easy - 1 Point Questions
